100th Anniversary Reunion Celebration Postponed to 2021

It was with regret and hope that the MMCA Council voted unanimously at its meeting on May 11 to postpone the 100th Anniversary Reunion of the Micum McIntire Clan Association to 2021. The uncertainty of scheduling, questions of affordability, and the risks to members' health were simply too great given the current pandemic, and we were informed by dozens of other similar summer and fall events that have been cancelled or postponed. This postponement will give the Council an opportunity to fine-tune the program of the Reunion to better meet the needs of all members in these unique circumstances. We received some very useful feedback following our request for input in the last newsletter, and will be putting it to good use for planning next year's event.

Annual Meeting to be Online

We are hoping to organize a Zoom annual meeting for the Clan Association over the summer, to get some basic Clan Association business done—principally the election of officers. We are well aware that some of our members are not computer-savvy, but we encourage you to talk to your friends and family members for help. We hope that each of you can participate. The visual connection that Zoom offers is so much better than not having any contact till next summer. As this pandemic has proceeded, online meetings have increasingly become a standard way for people to gather and to conduct business. We encourage you to investigate it. April Newsletter Survey Summary

In the April newsletter we sent out a short membership survey via snailmail letters and emails. Twenty-three people (about 17%) responded. Of those, 8 wanted to postpone the 100th anniversary celebration but keep the business meeting this year. Fourteen (14) members preferred to cancel both the business meeting and the anniversary for 2020. Two members wrote letters raising questions regarding membership eligibility, the work of the clan, wanting to do something different besides the traditional noon bring-your-own lunch and dessert swap, and challenges, especially for elders, in attending an evening ceilidh. The Council is working to address these issues, with guidance from our Bylaws.
